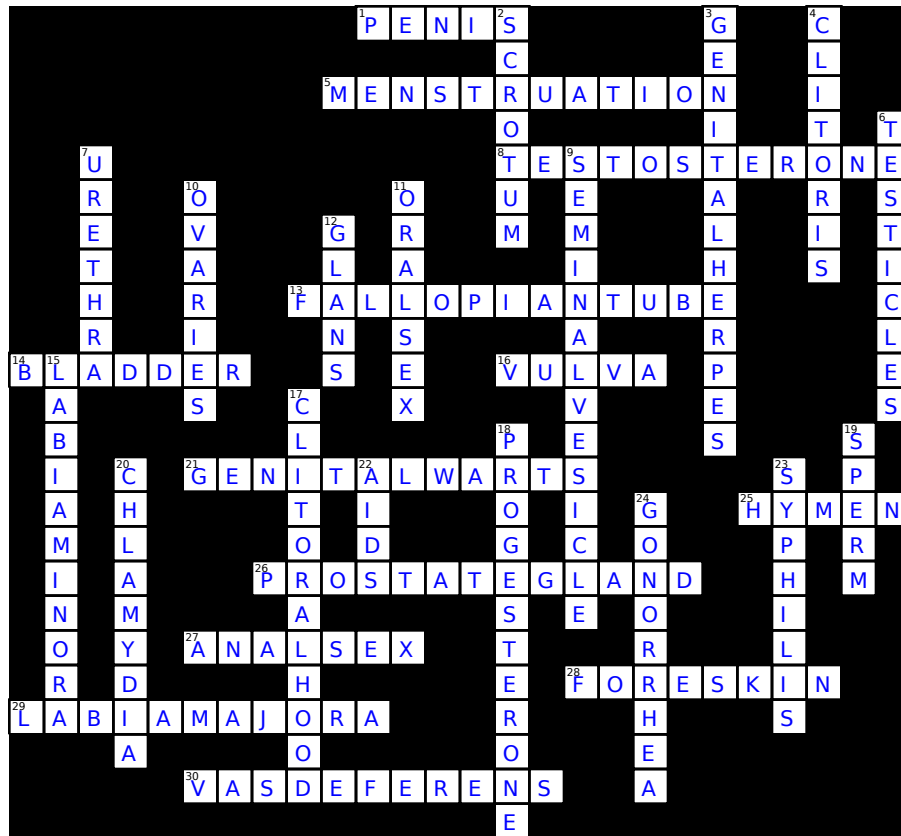


# Sexual Education

#### Across

- 1 The male sexual organ.
- 5 A women's monthly bleeding.
- 8 The male sex hormone.
- 13 Either of a pair of tubes extending from the uterus to the paired ovaries, also called oviducts or the uterine tube. (2 words)
- 14 The place where urine collects.
- 16 The name of the female's sexual pubic area.
- 21 The common name for the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). (2 words)
- 25 The thin mucous membrane that completely or partially covers the opening of the vaginal vagina.
- 26 Produces Seminal Fluid. (2 words)
- 27 A type of sex, where something is inserted into the Anus opening. (2 words)
- 28 A fold of skin that covers the end of the penis, sometimes removed by Circumcision.
- 29 The outer lips coving the Vaginal opening. (2 words)
- 30 A pair of ducts that carry sperm from the testes to the urethra during ejaculation. (2 words)

- 17 A fold of skin that surrounds and protects the clitoral glans. (2 words)
- 18 a sex hormone produced in women, first to prepare the womb for the fertilized ovum, and later to maintain pregnancy.
- 19 The cells produced by males that will fertilize the female's egg.
- 20 a STD, the most common with near 3 million infected. Often producing no symptoms, it can cause infertility, chronic pain, or a tubal pregnancy.
- 22 The current number one killer STD in the world.
- 23 A venereal disease caused by infection with the spirochete Treponema pallidum. It can cause Insanity.
- 24 A STD disease that causes inflammation of the genital mucous membrane, burning pain when urinating, and a discharge.
